INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.60 dated 22.05.2016, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar, under Sections 307, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and perused the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, the present petitioner is named and he is stated to be armed with .12 Bore gun, but from the perusal of record, it is found that he has not fired from the gun and no

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specific injury is attributed to him. He is not the main accused.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and no useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody. No active role is attributed to the present petitioner. No active role is attributed to the present petitioner in the commission of offence.

Without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in the present petition and the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, petitioner be released on anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
