Petitioner Anil alias Tinkel has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.201 dated 16.10.2015 registered at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal, under Sections 148, 323, 325, 341, 307, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikas Chopra, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR and is stated to be armed with pistol. It is also alleged that the petitioner has fired a shot on the vehicle in which the complainant's party was going on. It is further alleged that the petitioner has assaulted the complainant's party with iron rod and *danda*. However, no specific injury

has been attributed the petitioner with *danda* and iron rod. At this stage, learned State counsel points out that *danda* has already been recovered from the possession of present petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 05.05.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
