The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.126, dated 7.7.1999, registered under Sections 447, 427, 148, 149 of
the IPC, at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that when the petitioner was
abroad, the main case was decided on the basis of compromise and all
other accused persons were acquitted. The compromise has taken place

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with the petitioner also. He has relied upon the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Lavesh v. State (NCT of Delhi) (SC), 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 240.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from HC Surinder Pal, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, this petition is allowed and as undertaken, if the petitioner comes back and surrenders on or before 21.10.2016, the trial Court will release him on bail to its satisfaction.
