Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 24.10.2015 for having been found in possession of 5 kg. of opium.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjinder Singh submits that out of 13 cited witnesses, only 5 remain to be examined.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that prosecution will produce the entire remaining evidence within a period of five months from the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court. In case, all the witnesses of the prosecution are not examined within said period, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail after expiry of the said period on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
