The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.188 dated 20.08.2016 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 02.09.2016.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner and his son had agreed to sell the property to the complainant. He further submits that the son of the petitioner has died and thereafter the petitioner is not willing to perform part of his contract. In my opinion, looking to these

submissions the nature of dispute prima facie appears to be of civil in nature.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 02.09.2016 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
