Learned State counsel submits that he does not have any objection if the relief being sought in the petition is allowed.

Keeping in view that there appears to be reasonable apprehension of threat to life and personal liberty of the petitioner against certain private individuals in Sonipat against whom he has already got registered a complaint, copy of which has been placed on record as Annexure P/2 and keeping in view the ends of justice and that the parties should not be denied access to justice and justice must be actually done, the matter pending before the Civil Judge, Junior Division-cum-Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kharkhoda, District Sonipat is transferred to District Panipat. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat may keep the matter with him or entrust it to some competent Court.
