Quashing of FIR No.60 dated 11.03.2015, under Sections 465, 506, 354-D IPC and 66 of Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana is sought on the basis of compromise dated 25.07.2016 (Annexure P-2).

The FIR was registered on the basis of statement made by Jaswinder Singh @ Shammi-respondent No.2 alleging that his elder daughter, who is married, was being harassed by Hairmilan Singh, who used to call her from his mobile and harass; and by forging documents he was black-mailing her. In this background, the FIR was got registered.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide compromise dated 25.07.2016 (Annexure P/2). In compliance of order dated 02.09.2016, report dated 01.11.2016 of Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Ludhiana, has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioner. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioner.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case *Madan Mohan Abbot Vs. State of Punjab*, 2008 (2) RCR (Criminal) 429, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in case *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another*, 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation between the parties.

Accordingly, FIR No.60 dated 11.03.2015, under Sections 465, 506, 354-D IPC and 66 of Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana, is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
