This is an application moved by Anand Kumar S/o Ram Kumar, during the course of jail inspection from Central Jail, Ambala, Haryana to the Hon'ble Chief Justice of this High Court which was treated as criminal miscellaneous and notice of motion was issued to the respondents.

As per the contents of the application, applicant-Anand Kumar who is convicted in case FIR No. 163, dated August 08, 2004, under Sections 342, 354, 376, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh, in which

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he has been sentenced to under R.I. For 7 years and to pay a fine of Rs.8,300/- and in default of payment of fine, he shall further undergo R.I. for 01 years, 02 months & 15 days.

Through this application he has sought transfer from Central Jail, Ambala (Haryana) to Central Jail, Burel, Chandigarh. The matter with regard to the transfer of the jail is required to be dealt with and disposed of by I.G. (Prisons). But till date, no such application seeking transfer has been moved to I.G. (Prisons) either by the applicant in person or through any other person duly authorized on his behalf.

The instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the applicant to move an appropriate application to I.G. (Prisons) which shall be dealt with and disposed of without any delay by the concerned authority(s).
