This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.374 dated 22.06.2015, under Sections 353/188/379/307/186/120B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

On 16.02.2016, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Allegations against the present petitioner as also co-accused are with regard to driving of Dumper truck and engaging in illegal sand mining. Further accusation is that upon being stopped by a police patrolling party, an attempt was made to run over the police officials.

During the course of arguments, it has gone

uncontroverted that the dumper truck allegedly driven by the present petitioner had not struck against any police vehicle and neither has any of the officials of the patrolling party suffered any injury whatsoever.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sanjay Kumar apprises the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

In view of the above, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 16.02.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
