Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Parveen in case FIR No.0751 dated 25.08.2015, under Sections 323, 325, 307, 506, 120-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station City Karnal (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations in the FIR, the main accused Naresh @ Chottu and Kamal @ Kamaljeet along with other friends entered the shop of the complainant-Roshan Lal, who closed the door and thereafter the accused are alleged to have fired shots, which hit the door.

It is contended that it is a no injury case.

Four other non-applicants/co-accused including the main accused Naresh and Kamal have since been granted regular bail by this Court.

The only role attributed to the petitioner is that of being armed with a *Danda*, which has surfaced in the investigation.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 18.11.2015 and the evidence of prosecution is yet to commence.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Vijay Kumar, is unable to refute the aforesaid factual contention.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the parity of treatment; custody period and the fact that trial is at the initial stage, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Parveen deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
