The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.128, dated 4.6.2016, registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the main accused was arrested with 8 kgs of poppy husk and named the petitioner as a supplier, and that the antecedents of the petitioner are clear.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from SI

Gurmukh Singh, has accepted the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 24.09.2016 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires his presence, and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
