This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.51 dated 29.01.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 307 (added later on) IPC at Police Station-Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody since 02.02.2016 and the injury attracted Section 307 IPC is

attributed to the co-accused. He further argued that the victim has been discharged from the hospital.

Learned DAG, Haryana on instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
