The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.126 dated 28.05.2016, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC, Police Station Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner says that the petitioner is in custody since 01.07.2016 and challan is ready. He says that the girl is under 18 but more than 16 years of age.

The victim had left the house on 27.05.2016 and she returned on 01.06.2016 and refused to get her medical done. In the statement made under Section 164 Cr.P.C. she stated that she had gone on her own as she wanted to marry the petitioner and wanted to go with him.

The trial will take time. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
