This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.171 dated 28.09.2014, registered under Sections 399, 402 IPC and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Laddowal, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner was regularly

appearing before the trial Court and had moved an application for

exemption but the same was declined and the bail bonds forfeited. He further states that the petitioner had never misused the concession of bail.

Let the petitioner surrender before the Court on the date fixed which is stated to be 08.09.2016 and in case it is correct that he had never misused the concession of bail prior to this date, the trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
