This is second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 03.06.2014, under Sections 20 of the *Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985* (for short “NDPS Act”), registered at Police Station, Bhogpur, Distt. Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the State submits that prosecution evidence is in process. Out of total 08 witnesses, 02 witnesses have already been examined.
