JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure by seeking regular bail in case FIR No.31 dated 08.02.2016, under Sections 279, 336, 337, 365, 201, 338, 216, 304 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station, Sadar Dadwali, District Sirsa.

Undisputably, the name of the petitioner did not figure in the FIR and he has been nominated as one of the accused as per the disclosure statement suffered by his co-accused, namely, Jagmeet Singh @ Jaggi. The co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Gurmeet Singh and Harbans Kaur had already been granted the concession of bail by different orders. Petitioner is also suffering incarceration since the date of his surrender before the trial Court i.e. 17th February, 2016. It is also not disputed that after the completion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented which is pending disposal before the trial Court. The disposal of the trial would certainly take sufficient long time and cannot be concluded in a short span of time.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
