This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 64 dated 07.07.2016, under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC registered at Police Station Women Police Station, District Patiala (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel on instructions has informed that after joining investigation recovery of only 4 tolas have been effected, whereas they have bills of 23 tolas of gold.

The only dispute is about 20 tolas of gold.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the case, interim bail is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit an FD of ₹ 3 lacs in the name of the minor child within a period of one month and another FD of ₹ 2 lacs within a period of nine months before the

trial Court. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
