In view of six prosecution witnesses having been examined and six having been given up and five remaining to be examined, I do not find any ground to grant concession of bail to the petitioner in this case of recovery of 325 kg of poppy husk.

This petition is dismissed. However, trial Court is directed to make an earnest endeavour to examine the remaining witnesses within a period of three months after the next date of hearing and conclude the trial as soon as possible. In case, the trial is not concluded within a period of three months after the next date of hearing, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.
