INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners, Jagdeep Singh, Daljit Singh, Sukhvir Singh, Jarnail Singh, Gurmeet Singh and Kashmir Gir have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.164 dated 3.8.2016 registered for the offences under Sections 420, 447 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners have already joined

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the investigation. They are now not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from them. The main case is based on revenue record and the proceedings before the revenue officials etc. are pending between the parties. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody. Moreover, co-accused, Nazar Singh, has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 27.10.2016 passed in CRM-M-32771-2016.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The interim order dated 05.09.2016 passed by this Court granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
