Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.131 dated 29.07.2012 registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 34 and 326 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Dera Bassi, Distirct SAS Nagar, the petitioners as well as the complainant seek quashment of FIR by way of compounding/compromise.

Ms. Richa Mittal, counsel for respondent No.2 as well as the learned counsel for the petitioners state that indeed there is a compromise (Annexure P-2) has been arrived at between the parties. This Court vide order dated September 05, 2016 had directed the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of the compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Now, there is a report received from Sub Divisional Judicial

Magistrate, Dera Bassi, showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded and compromise that is arrived at between the parties with the intervention of the respectable persons is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

Looking to the nature of the offences registered in FIR and terms of compromise deed (Annexure P-2), I think, parties should be allowed to compound/compromise the offences in order that they live in peace and harmony.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.131 dated 29.07.2012 registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 34 and 326 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Dera Bassi, Distirct SAS Nagar is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
