In FIR No.19 dated 27.02.2014, under Section 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Phase 11, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, petitioner seeks quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent No.3-complainant jointly submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court vide order dated 24.09.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned

Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) stating

that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is found to be genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.19 dated 27.02.2014, under Section 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Phase 11, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed qua petitioner, by way of compounding/ compromise.
