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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.9 dated 19.03.2015 registered under Sections 364, 342, 323, 506, 148 & 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25, 27, 25(54), 59 Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga, in view of compromise (Annexure P-1).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent/complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 05.09.2016 asking for recording of statement of the parties in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court through the District and Sessions Judge, Moga. I have perused the same. In my opinion, the quashment of FIR by way of compromise/compounding in view of statements recorded, deserves to be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-31124 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.9 dated 19.03.2015 registered under Sections 364, 342, 323, 506, 148 & 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25, 27, 25(54), 59 Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga, is quashed by way of compromise/compounding qua the petitioners only along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
