JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure by Ninder Singh seeking regular bail in case FIR No.10 dated 07.01.2015, under Sections 15 and 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station, City Sangrur, during the pendency of the trial.

Undisputably, petitioner was not arrested at the spot. However, after completion of the investigation when the matter was pending before the trial Court, petitioner surrendered on 1st July, 2016. Prior to that, the petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail as the report of the Chemical Examiner was not received. Moreover, the recovery was effected at the spot in the absence of the petitioner when he has alleged to have been accompanied his wife. The wife of the petitioner has already been arrested by the police and recovery had already been effected. After completion of the investigation, report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented which is being faced by the petitioner. The disposal of the trial is not likely in the near future.

Taking into consideration all these aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds as per the satisfaction of concerned Id. trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
