Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 53 dated 22.06.2015, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, District Patiala.

The parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 16.10.2015.

Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre has been received that the parties could not arrive at any amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to Annexure P-3 and states that pursuant to order dated 08.09.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.09.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
