In FIR No.205 dated 24.05.2013, under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar, petitioner seeks quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent-complainant jointly submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court vide order dated 15.09.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned JMIC, Dera Bassi stating that the statements have been recorded and the

compromise is found to be genuine and voluntarily with free will of the parties without any coercion or undue influence or pressure.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.205 dated 24.05.2013, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
