TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.253 dated 15.07.2015, under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

Allegations in a nutshell are that co-accused, namely, Nirmala had set up a forged sale deed by entering particulars of the land belonging to the complainant and on the strength thereof attempted to take possession.

On 09.10.2015, petitioner had been directed to join investigation and interim protection as regards arrest had been granted.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation. It has also gone uncontroverted that insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, his role was that of being a marginal witness on the alleged sale deed. Furthermore, this Court in terms of order carrying even date has granted concession of pre-arrest bail to main accused, Nirmala in

CRM No.M-30472 of 2015.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 09.10.2015 is made absolute.
