INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail for two months w.e.f. 05.09.2016 to 05.11.2016 in case FIR No.55 dated 14.04.2016, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh District Sangrur, under Section 18 of NDPS Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

There is no medical record placed on file except one certificate issued by Kishan Singh Hospital, Hodal, Palwal wherein it is stated that on investigation, wife of the present petitioner is found to be suffering from severe anemia and menorrhagia and she needs operation at the earliest with four units of blood transfusion.

Firstly, this certificate is issued by a private hospital and secondly it is not corroborated by any medical document or report. The said

certificate alone is insufficient to grant interim bail to the petitioner. Moreover, recovery of 5 kg opium was effected from the present petitioner and non-petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of interim bail. Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
