JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure by Gurlal Singh @ Lala seeking regular bail in case FIR No.47 dated 18.06.2015, under Sections 457, 380 IPC and further added Sections 411, 413 IPC registered at Police Station, Kot Dharmu, District Mansa.

It is an undisputed fact that after the completion of investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has been presented in the Court of jurisdictional Magistrate and the petitioner is facing the trial. The co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Sunny @ Jas and Vijay Kumar @ Sonu similarly situated had granted the concession of bail by this Court by different orders. The case of the petitioner is not on different footing than those of Sunny @ Jas and Vijay Kumar @ Sonu. The conclusion of the trial would certainly take sufficient long time. The petitioner is suffering incarceration since the date of his arrest i.e. October 16, 2015. Learned State counsel submits that there are some other cases of similar nature pending against the petitioner but he is facing the trial in those

cases.

Taking into consideration all these aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds as per the satisfaction of concerned ld. trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
