The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.357 dated 10.11.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, under Sections 307, 34, 195, 353, 186, 182, 211, 120-B IPC.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Sanjeev Patter, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Sirsa has been filed. Same is taken on record. As per the said certificate, the applicant-appellant has undergone more than 08 months of custody.

The trial of the case is not likely to conclude in the near future.

Keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the applicant-appellant, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner.
