This is a petition which has been filed under Section 439
Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58 dated
03.02.2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406 & 506 IPC

at P.S. Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the challan has been filed and the charges have been framed. Further he argues that the present is a case of Magisterial trial and that the petitioner has been in custody since 25.04.2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
