On instructions from ASI Harpreet Singh, State counsel informs that all the prosecution witnesses stand examined except for one. Next date of hearing before the trial Court is 29.3.2016.

Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that there are number of statutory violations and contradictions which are indicative of false implication of the petitioner.

Taking into consideration the stage of the case, avoiding expression of any opinion on merit, I dismiss the petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas of fact and law before the trial Court expecting that trial Court shall expeditiously dispose of the trial. In case the trial is not concluded within a period of three months, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.
