Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.45 dated 05.04.2016 registered under Section 379-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rahon, District SBS Nagar, the petitioner was arrested on 15.05.2016 and is in jail since then. Admittedly, the challan has been filed. The other co-accused namely Kulvir Singh and Jasbir singh have been released on bail from whom the recovery was made. Learned counsel for the State pointed out that one more similar type of offence under Sections 457 and 379 is registered against the present petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would not indulge in such type of offence. The prosecution case is that the accused persons had snatched ₹1,500/- and one Mobile Phone mark 'LAVA' from the complainant.

In that view of the matter, bail petition is allowed. Learned counsel for the petitioner would undertake that the petitioner would not commit any similar offence or such type of offence in future. Bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
