TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.253 dated 15.07.2015, under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

In a nutshell, allegation against the present petitioner is with regard to having set up a forged sale deed pertaining to a parcel of land and in which particulars of land belonging to the complainant were also mentioned. Further allegations are that on the strength of such forged sale deed, possession of the land was also sought to be taken.

On 05.10.2015, petitioner was directed to join investigation and interim protection as regards arrest was granted.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Still further, State counsel would submit that even though the allegations are with regard to an attempt having been made to take possession of the land belonging to the complainant but infact the

possession is not with the petitioner/accused herein.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 05.10.2015 is made absolute.
