For having been found in possession of 500 grams of intoxicating powder containing Alprazolam, the petitioner has been in custody for the last ten months after having enjoyed interim bail for seven months during the awaiting period of report of Forensic Science Laboratory.

Counsel for the petitioner vehemently contended that the petitioner has not misused his liberty during the period of interim bail as such he may be granted the concession of regular bail during the pendency of the trial.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case in context to the quantity of Alprazolam recovered and the status of the trial.

State counsel informs that all the prosecution witnesses stand examined. In view of the status of the trial, it transpires that trial will last within two months.

Counsel for the petitioner at this stage seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach this Court in case the trial is not concluded within two months after the next date of hearing.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
