2. At the instance of this Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

3. By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case FIR No.29, dated 13.04.2012, under Sections 279, 304-A and 427 IPC, Police Station Singh Bhagwantpura, Rupnagar.

4. Undisputably, the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 01.04.2013. Subsequently, proceedings initiated against the petitioner were consigned under Section 299 Cr.P.C. by the Id. Magistrate.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to appear/surrender before the trial court within a period of 7 days from the date of

receipt of certified copy of this order and move an application for regular bail, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by the concerned Court within a period of 7 days from the date of its presentation.
