The petitioner is attributed a *khirch* blow on the left side of the stomach of the complainant, namely Nar Singh.

On asking of the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner informs that the complainant and his brother, namely Bhagwan Singh, stand already examined.

The petitioner has been attributed a grievous injury as per the record. He has been in custody, w.e.f. 22.05.2015.

Taking into consideration the fact that the material witnesses have already been examined and chances of tampering with the evidence are remote, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
