This order will dispose of an application for grant of bail in FIR No.708 dated 13.10.2015, under Sections 379-A, 201 IPC which was registered at the instance of Anil Kumar alleging that on 12.10.2015 when he was going back to his house in his car, he was waylaid by a vehicle and his car had been taken away by two boys, who had been following him. The complainant also levels allegation that he was thrown out of the car at unknown place by forcibly taking away his car.

The petitioner is though not named in the FIR or identified but he has been involved in the present case on the basis of statement of a taxi driver of Ola Car Service that it was the petitioner himself who had indulged in the act of extortion.

Recovery has already been effected. The petitioner appears to have a plausible defence that he has been involved in two cases on the basis of testimonies of taxi drivers who are connected to Ola Car Service.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
