Petitioner along with his co-accused was arrested while planning to commit dacoity at petrol pumps, banks and liquor vends. The petitioner was involved in the case on the basis of secret information that he along with 4-5 other co-accused had formed a gang and possessed legal arms.

On the instructions of ASI Malkit Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner is involved in seven more cases of similar nature registered prior to the present case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is on bail in all the cases, except for two cases, in which the bail applications are pending. The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 08.03.2016. The prosecution witnesses being police officials, chances of tampering with the evidence are remote.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Petitioner

will be released from custody on receipt of release order from the trial Court in case he is not required to be detained in any other case.
