The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 39 dated 06.05.2011 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 406/506/34 IPC at Police Station Ghuman, Distt. Gurdaspur alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 01.09.2015 (*Annexure P-2*).

Report of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala, has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is

voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their money dispute, therefore, FIR No. 39 dated 06.05.2011 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 406/506/34 IPC at Police Station Ghuman, Distt. Gurdaspur stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings, on the basis of compromise dated 01.09.2015 (*Annexure P-2*).

In view of the above, the petition stands allowed.
