Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.67 dated 20.2.2015, registered under Section 406 IPC at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

The report of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused. In this case, allegations of embezzlement of some amount had been levelled. In his statement, the complainant has stated that he has no objection if the FIR in question is quashed. He has also admitted the compromise Annexure C-2.

Keeping in view the fact that both the parties have amicably settled their dispute which was of financial nature, FIR No.67 dated 20.2.2015, registered under Section 406 IPC at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana, along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is allowed accordingly.
