The petitioners pray for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.48 dated 01.02.2016 registered under Sections 342, 395 and 420 IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Samalkha District Panipat.

The allegations against the petitioners are that they entered the dairy farm of the brother of the complainant and took away 12 buffalos after tying up his servants as well as snatching their mobile phones.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that no recovery of buffalos has been made from the petitioners and the petitioners are in custody for the last 6½ months and their antecedents are clean.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mukesh Kumar has accepted this factual assertions.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny them the concession of bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate,
Panipat.

The present petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending
criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
