Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondent No.2-complainant has filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act against the petitioner and on 17.11.2015 petitioner could not appear before the trial Court. Accordingly, his bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled. He further states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within a week and undertake that he will not absent himself in the case in future during pendency of the case.

Learned counsel for the complainant has argued that by such act and conduct the petitioner intends to delay the trial.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, the trial Court shall admit him on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction. The trial Court shall further expedite the trial.
