This is a petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 342 dated 14.11.2014 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana.

Allegations, in brief, against the petitioner are that he along with 5-6 co-accused was found in possession of 260 grams of intoxicant powder. It is contended by learned the learned counsel for the petitioner that earlier the petitioner was released on interim bail on 23.07.2015 and after receipt of report of Chemical Examiner, he was again taken into custody. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.

On the other hand, learned State counsel contends that the quantity recovered from the petitioner is commercial in nature and the petitioner is involved in another case also.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

Considering the fact that the quantity recovered from the petitioner is commercial in nature and the petitioner is involved in another case also, no ground for grant of bail is made out. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
