Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
is for quashing of FIR No.16 dated 21.1.2016, under Section 346
IPC, registered at Police Station Ellenabad (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of
affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Beniwal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent
of Police, Ellenabad. The contents of reply shows that the police
has already prepared a cancellation report, which is likely to be
submitted before the concerned Magistrate, of course after

approval of senior officers.

Considering the fact that the police has already prepared the cancellation report, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of as having become infructuous.

It is made clear that in case the cancellation report is not accepted by the Magistrate, the petitioners would be at liberty to file fresh petition for the similar relief as claimed in the present petition.
