Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.225 dated 18.11.2013, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 471, 472 and 473 read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 9.9.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to

order dated 9.9.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Dharampal, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 9.9.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
