Petitioners have preferred the present revision petition against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 27.09.2009 passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phagwara, whereby petitioner Subhash Sharma was convicted under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and was sentenced to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for a period of 01 year and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for a period of 2 months. The appeal filed by the petitioners was dismissed by learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala vide judgment dated 11.09.2006.

A perusal of the file reveals that no one had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners on 02.08.2016 and the matter was adjourned to 05.09.2016. On 05.09.2016 since no one had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners, the matter was finally posted for arguments for today.

Today again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It seems that the petitioners are no more interested in pursuing the present revision petition.

Present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.

Petitioner No.1 is on bail in this case. His bail/ surety bonds shall stand cancelled. The concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate, shall get the convict arrested and commit him to prison for serving the remaining period of sentence and shall take necessary steps, to comply with the order, with due promptitude, keeping in view the applicability of the provisions of Section 428 Cr.P.C., and submit compliance report, to this Court, within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of a copy thereof.

The Registry shall keep track of the submission of compliance report and put up the papers, whether the reports are received or not within the time frame, immediately after the expiry thereof.
