By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. petitioners have sought issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to take appropriate action against respondent Nos.4 to 8 who have allegedly committed the offence under Sections 323, 326, 307, 447, 436, 506, 148, 149 & 120-B of IPC as well as for getting an inquiry against the officials respondents posted in Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though petitioner No.2 has also sustained injuries as is evidence from the copy of MLR (Annexure P-6) and further that house of the petitioners was set at ablaze by the private respondents. But till date no action has been taken on the complaint/representation dated April 22, 2016 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioners. Rather, FIR No. 53, dated June 07, 2016, under Sections 323, 341 & 34 of IPC, Police Station Julkan, District Patiala has been

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registered against the petitioners. Learned counsel further contends that even the investigation still in progress. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to enquire into the various aspects mentioned in their representation dated April 22, 2016 (Annexure P-8) within a specified period.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The instant petition is disposed of, with the direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated April 22, 2016 (Annexure P-8) along with FIR No. 53, dated June 07, 2016, under Section 323, 341 & 34 of IPC, Police Station Julkan, District Patiala and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
