The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.206, dated 4.9.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 506, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Kosli, Rewari.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is not the main accused; the main accused has not been arrested, while the petitioner has been in custody since 5.7.2016, and it is a Magisterial trial.

Counsel for the respondent has not denied the factual

assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
