Prayer in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Charanjit Kaur is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 219, dated 15.12.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar.

As per allegations petitioner was apprehended on 15.12.2015 at around 5.00 p.m. carrying 57 grams of some intoxicating powder. The petitioner was arrested and taken to police station from where she is alleged to have absconded.

It was contended that the petitioner is a middle aged widowed lady and not involved in any other criminal case and a false case has been planted upon the petitioner on account of contents of para 5 of the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 29.01.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Avtar Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and further states that her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioner by this Court's order dated 29.01.2016, is made absolute.
