Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.80 dated 13.5.2014, under Sections 323, 353, 186, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar.

This Court vide order dated 19.9.2016 has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 19.9.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Mukhtiar Singh,

has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 19.9.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
